### Special Issue #2: Effects of Sound in the Ocean on Marine Mammals

The focus of ESOMM-2018, similar to previous ESOMM meetings, is to link science to policy and regulation by inviting combined representation of the research, policy and regulation communities. By doing so, we hope to facilitate and reinforce this multi stakeholder interaction. Originating as a NATO meeting, the main focus for ESOMM will be the environmental effects of sonar sound; but over the years other sound sources have increasingly been considered as well. Exchange of knowledge is encouraged between different communities and industries on other sound sources, such as the oil & gas industry.

This Special Issue is tentatively scheduled for late Autumn 2019 publication. Related deadlines and details are below.

Manuscript submission has two deadlines with manuscripts accepted for review between these dates:

1<sup>st</sup> deadline – 15 December 2018

2<sup>nd</sup> ultimate deadline – 31 January 2019
